

Independent Textiles course description/syllabus:

**Students registering for this class must have instructor's approval.
Admission based on successful completion of Textiles I and II**

Students will complete projects in this course demonstrating an advanced knowledge of textile constructions. New techniques will be required on each project (examples: applique, prairie points, curves, 2 sided quilt etc). Students will be awarded weekly points based on work ethic, time management, responsibility for personal and school property.

Projects

Project 1 quilt design with new technique and pre-approved technique

Project 2 a quilt using new and pre-approved technique

Grades

Daily points (5 points) are awarded to the student based on the following: work ethic, time management, responsibility for personal and school property, and cooperation.

Points are recorded as a weekly total.

"0" points are given if absent. Students will need to make up class time to receive points. Make up time is arranged with the teacher.

Project are due on the posted date and a **15% deduction per day is enforced on all late work.**

Projects will be displayed at the Spring Show of the completion year.
